## Homeless Service Network – Meeting Minutes, March 17, 2021

- Department of Health Kathy
  - The county continues to get vaccine every week. There are vaccines available specifically for shelter clients and/or staff. These appointments will be at 111 Westfall. Send Kathy an email by the end of the day today with the person's name and contact information and their scheduling department will reach out to get these individuals vaccinated.
  - Katharine Hiltunen; <u>KathyHiltunen@monroecounty.gov</u>
  - Dome, hospitals and pop up site are available for vaccine.
  - For shelter residence who test positive and need to quarantine, are now going to the Riverside Hotel (this started about 2 weeks ago).
  - Quarantine guidelines are anticipated to loosen up starting April for those traveling into the state. Regulations will be released soon from the state level addressing quarantine guidelines for travelers who have been vaccinated.
  - County Timelines for Vaccination: about 83,000 already vaccinated in the county. The FEDs are stating we will have access to vaccinate all eligible folks by mid-June. The county is currently vaccinating those who are willing.

## Questions:

- What are some of the reasons folks are resistant to vaccines?
  - Long term effects
  - Not 100% effective
  - Ingredients some folks believe there are live ingredients which is not true
  - Communities of color specifically have a distrust of the medical system in general
  - Symptoms and side effects (reactions after receiving the vaccine)
  - If you have had COVID, do you need both shots of the vaccine?
    - It depends on the symptoms someone experiences when they had COVID. The recommendation is that everyone get vaccinated and get both doses. The recommendations is to take whatever vaccine type that is available.
  - If someone has experienced loss of taste or smell, do these systems come back?
    - There have been folks who have experienced these systems reoccur.
- Updates Becky

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- Email was sent to the shelters on Monday by Becky to schedule 20 or so folks for vaccinations with the county.
- Shelter system update: shelters continued to experience low shelter census but increased numbers of folks at the Civic Center. SOP, PCHO, OMH are working together to get these folks housed. So far, 2 folks from the Civic Center have been housed.
- The trend of positive COVID cases at shelter has declined.

  - Currently working on the Fall event which is going to be held at the Public Market. No date has been established yet, so stay tuned!

The goal is not for Joe to take over current relationships programs have established with landlord, but to support these relationships that already exist.
