

# ECHO:

## Substance Use Disorders and Co-occurring Mental Health Conditions



### Who is eligible to participate?

Primary care providers at all levels (including physicians, physicians assistants, nurses, psychologists, pharmacists, social workers, CASACs, mental health specialists, physical therapists, chiropractors), Peers, and suboxone providers with interest in building knowledge around how to treat substance use disorder and co-occurring mental health conditions.

### What is required to participate?

- Broadband internet connection.
- Webcam support device.
- 75 minutes biweekly to attend.
- Willingness to present 2 cases.
- Completion of periodic surveys evaluating knowledge, competence, and self-efficacy/outcomes.

### Why participate?

Your schedule is valuable. What does this ECHO project bring you? Participation will bring you specialty knowledge and:

- Free CME
- Non-judgmental guidance
- Coaching around how to handle the psychosocial needs of complex patients who have substance use disorder, and mental health conditions.
- Didactic presentation and case studies.

### How ECHO Works:

ECHO is a case-based education experience in which specialist providers, along with community clinicians, develop a “knowledge network.” Each session will last 75 minutes and will include a brief didactic presentation, followed by case-based educational discussions with content experts. The clinics will be held biweekly during the noon hour. We strongly encourage attending in person at Huther Doyle, however, there is a televideo option available if needed.
