

# FY 2026 HMIS Data Standards: Overview of Changes for End Users

PLEASE NOTE: FY 2026 HMIS DATA STANDARDS WENT INTO EFFECT ON OCTOBER 1, 2025.

## CHANGES IMPACTING ALL HMIS USERS:

- 🏠 **Sex** field added – List Options: *Male, Female, Client doesn't know, Client prefers not to answer, Data not collected* (available as of 10/1/2025).
- 🏠 **Gender** field retired.
- 🏠 **Translation Assistance Needed** and related fields (including **Preferred Language**) retired (will be removed from assessments).
- 🏠 **Sexual Orientation** field retired (will be removed from assessments).
- 🏠 **Race/Ethnicity** List Option Changed - *Hispanic/Latina/e/o* to *Hispanic/Latina/o* (available as of 10/1/2025).
- 🏠 **Additional Race and Ethnicity Detail** field changed to “**Additional Race and Ethnicity Detail (Optional)**” to clarify to users that this is an optional field and does not need to be completed (available as of 10/1/2025).

## DETAILS:

1. Addition of **Sex** field.
  - a. Because Gender represents an individual's self-expressed identity and Sex is a biological classification assigned at birth, HUD has directed HMIS software vendors to not copy the **Gender** field data into the **Sex** field.
  - b. Each client should be asked to complete the **Sex** field. Providers should not assume the answer to the **Sex** field based on a previous answer in the Gender field.
  - c. Data will be collected at the creation of a client record. Only one option can be selected.
  - d. List Options: *Male, Female, Client doesn't know, Client prefers not to answer, Data not collected*.
  - e. Data needs to be collected for all new clients as of October 1, 2025. Existing clients served October 1, 2025, and after will need to have the value for the Sex field entered in their Client Record.
  - f. **Sex** is a required field for HUD CoC, HUD ESG, HUD VASH, HHS RHY, VA SSVF, VA GPD, and other funders.
  - g. The following program types are required to collect Sex data: Street Outreach, Emergency Shelters, Safe Haven, Transitional Housing, Services Only, Permanent Supportive Housing, Rapid Re-Housing, Homelessness Prevention, and Permanent Housing (PH) – Housing Only.
  - h. Please see the screenshots below which display where the **Sex** field has been added to the **Summary** tab and the **Client Profile** tab. To enter/update data for this field, click the pencil next to the **Client Record** title.

The CoC will lead a discussion regarding the inclusion of the Gender field and request feedback over the next several weeks. The Gender field will remain available until a decision has been made.
3. **Translation Assistance Needed** and related fields (including **Preferred Language**) have been retired. They will be removed from all assessments.

## CHANGES FOR RHY PROGRAMS

- 🏠 The set of questions under **Family Critical Issues** will have an updated list of options to include, “*Client doesn’t know, Client prefers not to answer, and Data not collected.*”
- 🏠 Going back into prior entries to update the options selected is not required.
- 🏠 This covers the following:
  - Family Critical Issues**
    - Unemployment - Family member
    - Mental Health Disorder - Family member
    - Physical Disability - Family member
    - Alcohol or Substance Use Disorder - Family member
    - Insufficient Income to support youth - Family member
    - Incarcerated Parent of Youth - Family member

## CHANGES FOR VA PROGRAMS

### VA: Grant Per Diem (GPD) – Case Management/Housing Retention

- 🏠 **Housing Move-In Date** is now a required field. This applies to all actively enrolled and new clients as of October 1, 2025
- 🏠 **Mental Health Consultation Status** – NEW field added and required at project entry for head of household. The list values for this item are “*Mental health consultation completed,*” “*Mental health consultation being coordinated/arranged with VA provider,*” “*Mental health consultation being coordinated/arranged with other provider,*” and “*Offer declined.*”

### ALL VA: GRANT PER DIEM PROJECT TYPES

- 🏠 **Disabling Conditions** data collection is no longer required. This takes effect for all new clients as of October 1, 2025.

### HUD VASH

- 🏠 **Disabling Conditions** data collection is no longer required. This takes effect for all new clients as of October 1, 2025.

### SSVF

- 🏠 **Type of SSVF Service: Healthcare Navigation** has been added to the list of options for this field. When choosing this new service option, the Service Start Date must be 10/1/2025 or after.
- 🏠 **Financial Assistance – SSVF** – a new date field has been added for **Start Date of Financial Assistance**. This will be a required field when a value has been chosen for the SSVF Financial Assistance Type.
- 🏠 **HP Targeting Criteria** – updated wording for the following assessment questions (available as of October 1, 2025):

1. “Household size of 5 or more requiring at least 3 bedrooms (due to age/gender mix)” is changed to “Household size of 5 or more requiring at least 3 bedrooms (due to household composition).”
2. “Household includes one or more members of an overrepresented population in the homelessness system when compared to the general population” is changed to “Households which may include one or more members meeting other criteria for targeting prevention determined by the CoC.”

🏠 **Mental Health Consultation Status** – NEW field added and required at project entry for **SSVF RRH** and **SSVF HP**. The list values for this item are “*Mental health consultation completed,*” “*Mental health consultation being coordinated/arranged with VA provider,*” “*Mental health consultation being coordinated/arranged with other provider,*” and “*Offer declined.*” This is required for head of household.

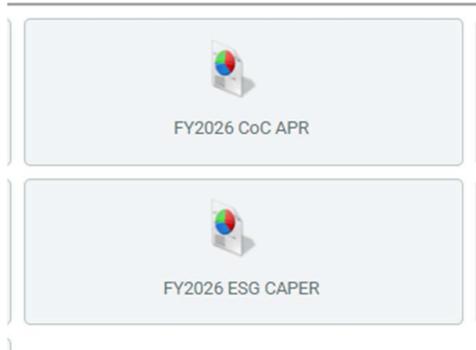
