If you have been in county or federal incarceration, our program can help you.

Re-entering society after incarceration brings serious challenges — from finding employment and housing to rebuilding family ties and addressing addiction and mental health. With support and opportunity, we assist individuals to overcome these obstacles and build a hopeful future.

Who is eligible for our program?

Persons with any of the following are eligible for services:

- You have been released from county or federal incarceration within the last year
- You are out on pre-trial
- You have an upcoming release date
- You have participated in the Reentry program in the past

Services we offer

- ✓ Assistance in applying for benefits through DHS such as food stamps, Medicaid and temporary assistance and help with keeping your case open at DHS.
- ✓ Connection to medical providers, substance use treatment and mental health treatment.
- ✓ Job readiness and assistance with preparing and searching for employment.
- ✓ Assistance with obtaining a social security card, birth certificate and/or a non-driver ID.
- ✓ Connection to and financial assistance with employment training opportunities.
- ✓ Transportation assistance.
- ✓ Life skills development.
- ✓ Referrals to community resources and pro-social outlets.
