

Partners Ending Homelessness Notice of Funding Opportunity Scoring and Ranking Methodology for FY2025

Partners Ending Homelessness (PEH) Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) process aims to distribute HUD Continuum of Care (CoC) Program funding to projects that effectively address homelessness in the region. It involves a local review committee of nonconflicted members, a tier-based funding system prioritizing performance, and an appeals process. The methodology is grounded in data-driven assessments, community collaboration, and adherence to HUD guidelines, with a focus on treatment, recovery, public safety, and self-sufficiency.

In the past, PEH has held a ‘blackout’ period during the application process and renewal, and new applicants were not permitted to ask questions of PEH staff during that period. As PEH (and all CoC’s) are still waiting for HUD to update the [FY2025 Continuum of Care Competition](#) with several pieces of critical information, we will not hold a blackout period.

Process

- **Application Release:** PEH releases local application and renewal materials, including the scoring rubric, which can be found on the PEH website. The local application will include 2024 monitoring results for currently funded projects (monitoring results are based on your SAGE APR for your year ending in 2024), and HMIS data from 10/1/23 to 9/30/24.
- **Reallocation Notification:** Projects intending to reallocate funds must notify PEH via email.
- **Application Submission:** Both E-Snaps and Local Applications are due. Local applications must be submitted via email, and E-Snaps applications must be submitted electronically.
- **Ranking and Review:** The non conflicted Ranking and Review Committee meets to score and rank projects based on local application criteria.
- **Ranking Announcement:** PEH announces the project rankings.
- **Appeals:** Projects can submit appeals in writing based on specific grounds.
- **Consolidated Application Publication:** PEH publishes the Consolidated Application and Priority List for public comment on their website.
- **HUD Submission:** PEH submits the Consolidated Application to HUD.
- **Award Notification:** Anticipated award date and performance period start date.

Rank and Review Committee training	December 8, 2025 at 11am
Your application must be submitted into E-Snaps (HUDs Application Portal), and a screenshot of your E-Snaps submission along with your Local Applications must be emailed to jkeys@letsendhomelessness.org . If E-Snaps doesn't open, please also email a copy of your budget workbook to jkeys@letsendhomelessness.org . The workbook will be emailed to providers and will be on the PEH Website .	December 10, 2025 at 5pm
Ranking and Review Committee meets; rankings are announced. Projects will need to revise E-Snaps applications and budget workbooks.	December 17, 2025 9:30a – 12:30p
Deadline to appeal.	December 22, 2025 at 12pm
PEH publishes Consolidated Application and Priority list, available for public comment on letsendhomelessness.org	January 7, 2026
Public comments due to treclemonds@letsendhomelessness.org	January 10, 2026 at 5pm
PEH submits Consolidated Application to HUD by 8pm	January 14, 2026 at 8pm
Anticipated award date and performance period start date	May 1, 2026
