- 🏠 System Performance Measures (SPM) Reporting period began on 3/14/2025 and ends on 4/11/2025 at 8:00 PM EST. On 3/21/2025, WellSky plans on releasing an update that will address calculation issues on the SPM Report. We will begin our submission after that date.
- 🏠 Point-In-Time/Housing Inventory Count (PIT/HIC) reporting delayed, no date set yet – Generally starts soon after the SPM Reports have been submitted.
- 🏠 We have not received any information regarding data changes needed as a result of the Presidential Executive Orders.

- HUD's Goal: To accurately reflect a person's identity to better serve them and to create a more inclusive environment for everyone experiencing homelessness.
- Feedback is due by May 31, 2025.

Last Month's Question: What data is most important to collect?

Responses:

- Reason for homelessness
- Length of time homeless
- Prior living situation
- Data that helps determine a client's needs and eligibility – current homeless status, income, disabilities, medical, mental health, household size, personal safety, food needs
- Demographics: Age, identified gender, sexual orientation, race, nationality, primary language, socio-economic information
