Considerations for the 2021 Point in Time and Housing Inventory Charts

The Point in Time Count (PIT) and Housing Inventory Chart (HIC) are two reports that are submitted to HUD annually. Data used for the reports is collected on one day during the last ten days of January each year. The effects of the COVID-19 pandemic are reflected for the first time in the 2021 reports as the shut down in NYS did not occur until the end of March 2020. The biggest changes that appear to be primarily due to COVID-19:

Sheltered Point in Time Count: This is a count of all people in emergency shelters, transitional housing including the Safe Haven and unsheltered homeless on January 21, 2021.

There have been significant decreases in the number of persons entering the homeless system since 3/2020. Some of the reasons for this reduction in numbers could include:

- Eviction Moratorium
 - Survey of Rochester and Monroe County landlords determined that approximately 25% of rental units had arrears
 - Anecdotal information from landlords confirms significant arrears and that there are tenants who have income but have chosen not to pay rent
- Fear of entering shelters during COVID-19 due to congregate living
- People have been able to continue to stay with family or friends for longer periods
- Households have had additional income from stimulus funding or increased unemployment benefits
- Decrease in requests for emergency housing placements through MCDHS

It is unknown at this time how long this will continue or what the effects will be on the homeless system when the eviction moratorium ends. There had been a downward trend in the number of households with children in the homeless system from 2018 - 2019; while the number of homeless individuals had remained fairly stable.

The major changes occurred in the Emergency Shelter system. This was primarily due to shelters needing to reduce their capacity to follow guidelines for social distancing. Due to the reduced numbers of households with children, there was also a shelter that closed completely. That shelter did eventually re-open as a seasonal warming center for individuals and those numbers are included in the PIT and HIC.

While the overall capacity (total number of beds) of the emergency shelter system was reduced by 20% the reduction in the PIT counts for the sheltered homeless decreased by 41% and the average utilization rate decreased by 23%.

Partners Ending Homelessness will continue to participate in and facilitate community conversations around these changes as we gain more information on the potential end of the eviction moratorium, outcomes from the historic increased funding for rental assistance, and the continued monitoring of the numbers served in the emergency shelters.
