The mission of the Consortium is to identify and engage community-based organizations that are uniquely positioned to address social determinants of health (SDOH) and provide the technical support needed so they may more effectively participate in DSRIP objectives to drive greater value, better outcomes and lower healthcare costs. The Consortium is actively working to strengthen CBO infrastructure and better prepare CBO's to demonstrate their value and participate in Value-Based payment arrangements.

Over the past year, the CBO Consortium has made many resources available to its members and affiliates, including an on-line Learning Management System and technical assistance resources. Although the Consortium is nearing the end of its initial planning year funding (to end on March 31<sup>st</sup>), resources remain to support additional member Tier 1 CBO's (non-profit organization; non-Medicaid billing; annual operating budget of less than \$5 million; 2+ years addressing SDOH) *to earn incentive dollars by participating* in training/learning activities through March. This can be as simple as joining the Consortium, accessing the LMS and receiving funds to watch a webinar! If your organization does not meet the criteria as a Tier 1 CBO, you may join as an affiliate member and access the resources but would not be eligible for incentive funding. Efforts are underway to continue the work of the Consortium past the initial planning grant phase. Many resources will continue to be made available to members.
